but is counted and told in God's story.

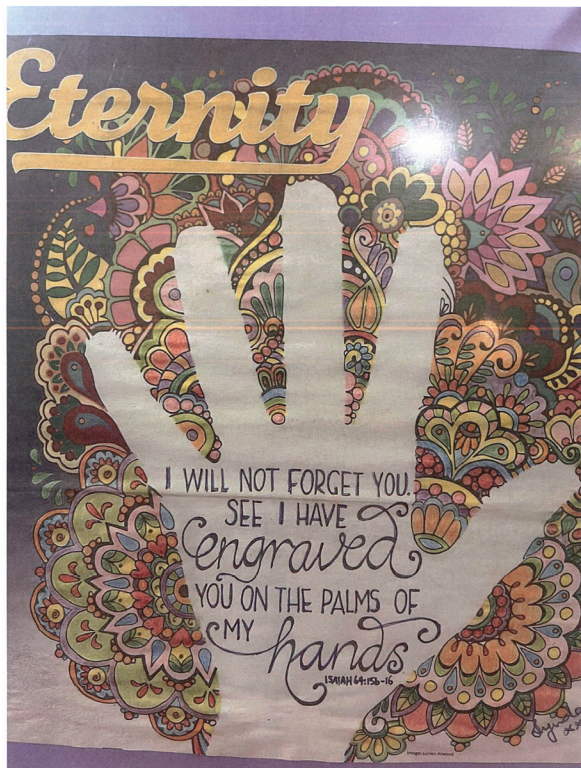
Nothing is lost to the eyes of God,
